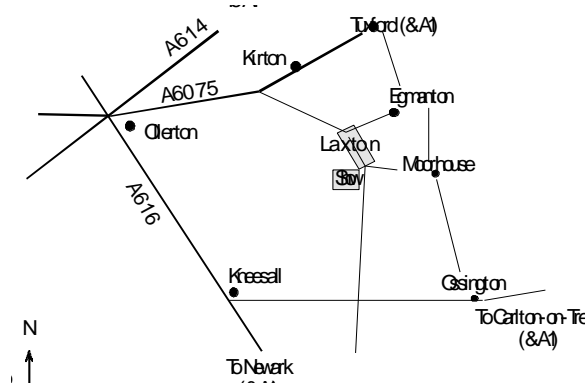

**Rules & Conditions of Entry**

1. The organisers and landowners cannot accept responsibility for any loss, damage to any person, animal or property howsoever caused.
2. Hard hats to PAS 015 or BSEN1384 must be worn at all times whilst mounted. Jackets should be worn in the jumping rings, no schooling whips allowed, back protectors are recommended for all jumping classes.
3. Age to be taken from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2010.
4. Lead rein competitors must be 8 years old or under.
5. No horse/pony under 4 years of age will be allowed to compete except in the in hand classes.
6. Any child entering lead rein classes must remain so all day, with the exception of the Beginners Show Jumping.
7. All lead rein ponies in show classes must be in a snaffle bridle with the lead rein attached to the noseband.
8. Any horse/pony entering novice SJ is not then eligible to enter the Open horse/pony
9. No refund of entry is given.
10. It is the judge's decision whether to allow spurs to be worn
11. Excessive use of the whip is not allowed anyone doing so will be asked to leave the showground.
12. No non-competitive entries allowed.
13. The judge's decision is final.
14. Any objection must be made in writing with a £20 deposit within 15 minutes of the class ending. This will be investigated by the show committee whose decision will be final.
15. Please take your litter home or use the bins provided
16. Keep dogs on leads at all times.
17. Horses/ponies must not be left unattended tied to horseboxes/trailers (unless inside the box /trailer).
18. NO person is allowed to enter any ring without the ring steward being present.
19. **All competitors must have third party liability cover.**
